

Accessing Your Child's STAAR 2017 Grades 3-8 Test Results

STAAR 2017 Grades 3-8 test results will be available on or after June 14. Districts are not receiving Confidential Student Reports (CSRs) until late summer due to the redesign of the reports by TEA. For this reason, student results will be made available to parents in the Texas Assessment Management System's Student Portal.

Go to www.texasassessment.com and click on "Log In to Student Portal." Click on "Lookup Access Code". Enter your child's First Name, Social Security Number (PEIMS ID) and Birthdate, and click Go. You will get an access code. Click Go again. Here you will view your child's testing history. Click on a test name for more information.

The performance standards have been redefined. The following chart is provided to illustrate what is considered passing and what is not considered passing for 2017:

Level II: Satisfactory	Approaches Grade Level (passing)
Level II: Recommended	Meets Grade Level (passing)
