PUBLIC NOTIFICATION FOR MEYERSVILLE ISD ON TCEQ COMPLIANCE

LEAD AND COPPER MONITORING

The Meyersville Independent School District water system PWS ID 0620011 violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to monitor for Lead and Copper and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ. During January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2014, we did not complete all monitoring and/or reporting for lead and copper, and therefore TECQ cannot be sure of the safety of the drinking water during that time.

We are working to correct the problem. Meyersville ISD subsequently contracted with a Class "D" Water Operator to correct this violation during the next required testing period set by TECQ and will therefore negate any future testing and reporting violations.
