

The Meyersville School water system PWS ID 0620011 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of the monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period of fourth quarter of 2013 quarterly reporting.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

Meyersville School did not report the quarterly report for October, November, and December of 2013. Meyersville School has records showing that all systems were in compliance with residual testing each week of these three months. We have the monthly reports showing that we are in compliance with water sampling for these three months. Meyersville School just forgot to report it to TCEQ for the quarterly reporting of the 4th quarter of 2013. In 2014, Meyersville School reported the first quarter of January, February, and March to TCEQ. As of now, Meyersville School is in compliance with TCEQ.
